# Leadership Institute Meeting (LIM)



### Lisbon - December 2023

The evolution of the human race has always been marked by our ability to adapt and innovate in the face of challenges. In today's rapidly changing world, embracing innovation and creativity is not just an option; it's a necessity. Recognizing this, PMI Finland Chapter proudly joins hands with PMI Sweden Chapter and chapters worldwide to foster inter-chapter collaboration on a groundbreaking initiative that explores the role of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in project management.



PMI's Sweden and Rio de Janeiro chapters, in close partnership with chapters across Europe, Brazil & Latin America, North America, India, and Asia, have embarked on a monumental endeavor. They aim to gain a global perspective on how AI is catalyzing change in digital transformation, especially within the realm of project management.

To achieve this goal, PMI chapters

worldwide have been invited to participate in a pivotal survey. This survey holds paramount importance in shedding light on the future of project management and organizational transformations through digital leadership. It's a journey that invites professionals from all corners of the world to shape the future of project management together.

The survey aims to assess the



knowledge and experience of the project management community and PMI members regarding AI implementation. It seeks insights into their readiness to embrace AI as a tool in project management. Questions delve into the types of AI solutions implemented, team preparation, challenges faced, and even the willingness to change employment if their current employer lags in adopting new technology like AI.

Furthermore, the survey investigates how companies are preparing for AI implementation. This includes assessing personnel training and the recruitment of AI specialists. It also takes into account the impact of demographic and geographic differences. The survey leverages the strength of being part of a global member network, inviting PMI volunteers to support this crucial work in understanding how individuals and organizations are adapting to AI a technology poised to impact us all.

### **Intermediate Findings**

As we close the survey on September 30th and look forward to PMI's approval by December 14th, we already have some intriguing intermediate findings from respondents:

- 88% of respondents are affiliated with PMI.
- 72% of responses are from male participants.
- 88% believe that AI will have a significant impact on project management.
- 63% have no prior experience working on AI projects.
- 64% perceive a low level of AI maturity in their organizations.
- 40% stated that their companies are actively building AI competence, with 16% focusing on Centers of Excellence (CoE) and 19% allocating resources to AI projects.
- 67% think that their companies invest inadequately in AI training.



### **Upcoming Steps**

With these preliminary findings in mind, we are gearing up for the next steps in this exciting journey:

- Analysis: We will analyze survey results, exploring demographics, geography, and industry perspectives.
- Comparison: We will compare our findings to predictions by prominent research institutions like Accenture and Gartner.
- Case Studies: We will share knowledge contributed by respondents and insights from AI

organizations.

• Expert Predictions: We will present predictions by AI experts.

In late December, we will provide a full report and extend invitations to a presentation where we will share the comprehensive survey results.

This global collaboration is not only an opportunity to explore the limitless possibilities that AI holds for project management but also to shape the way we work and lead in the digital age. Join us on this exciting journey, and together, we can define the future of project management in the era of AI.
