
world to pledge hours of service to projects and programs supporting one or more of the goals. By giving our time and our talents, we can all help build a more sustainable future leaving no one behind.

Raising Awareness About Project Management



Class of 2023 Mentoring Program Closure

This month we conclude the Class of 2023 Mentoring Program, we extend our heartfelt thanks to all our mentors and mentees. Your dedication and commitment have been vital to the success of this program. We hope that the experience has been as valuable and rewarding for you as it has been for us.

Program Feedback

The program received an average rating of 8.5 from participants, which reflects the high regard in which it is held. Many participants praised the program for its structure, the opportunities it provided for learning and development, and the new connections they were able to make. There was also a strong desire among many to continue the mentoring relationships they had formed.

Key Takeaways:

■ Structured Program with Clear Goals: The organized structure and clear objectives of the program were particularly appreciated. Participants felt that the program's framework helped them stay focused and achieve their goals.

- Opportunities for Learning and Development: Both mentors and mentees reported significant personal and professional growth. Mentors gained insights into leadership and coaching, while mentees benefited from the guidance and expertise of their mentors.
- Increased Network and Connections: The program facilitated valuable new connections and networking opportunities. Many participants highlighted how these connections have already started to benefit their professional lives.

Most participants found their mentor/mentee pairings to be well-matched. The thoughtful pairing process contributed to effective and meaningful mentoring relationships. However, there were some challenges that participants faced:

■ Balancing Commitments: Many participants struggled to balance the demands of the program with their other commitments, particularly during the long vacation season.



Scheduling conflicts were a common issue that affected the consistency of meetings.

- Clearer Target Setting: A need for clearer target setting at the beginning of the program was highlighted. Participants felt that having well-defined goals from the outset would help in measuring progress and achieving outcomes.
- Improved Communication:
 There were calls for better
 communication from PMI regarding
 program updates. Participants felt
 that more frequent and detailed
 updates would help them stay
 informed and engaged throughout
 the program.

Mentee Nominations

One of the highlights of the program was the mentee nominations. Mentors nominated mentees for their outstanding participation and commitment to the program. These nominations serve as a testament to



the dedication and effort put forth by these individuals. The recognition not only boosts the morale of the mentees but also encourages them to continue their professional development journey.

Program Closure Event

During the closure event, several important discussions took place. Concerns were raised about the lack of motivation among some mentees. To address this, it was suggested to expand the application base to reach more potential participants who are genuinely interested in the program. The discussions emphasized the importance of enhancing mentorship programs for project management students through improved marketing strategies, targeting universities, and providing educational sessions for mentors.

The value of mentorship in project management was reinforced by shared experiences from participants. They discussed how mentorship has helped them navigate their careers, build networks, and develop essential skills. Additionally, it was recommended to approach university alumni for additional support, leveraging their experience and connections to further strengthen the program.



The mentorship program has been a vital initiative for students, offering structured support and clear goals. Despite some challenges such as audio issues during virtual meetings and scheduling conflicts, the overall feedback has been overwhelmingly positive.

As we conclude this year's program, we are committed to implementing your feedback to improve our future initiatives. We aim to address the challenges faced and enhance the overall experience for both mentors and mentees. We look forward to fostering a supportive and enriching environment in the coming years.



have provided practical insights into adapting agile principles to various project environments.



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Climate Fresk - Engage in Climate Action

Introduction

Climate change poses a significant threat to our planet, and its impacts are increasingly evident in the form of rising temperatures, extreme weather events, and unprecedented environmental disruptions. Recognizing the urgency of this crisis, PMI Finland is proud to support the Climate Fresk initiative, a powerful workshop designed to raise awareness and foster action among project management professionals.

What is Climate Fresk?

Climate Fresk has been a global success, engaging over 1.3 million participants across 40 countries. This dynamic workshop provides a comprehensive understanding of Climate Science and the significant impacts highlighted by the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC). In just three hours, participants delve into the science through an interactive "card game" format, which makes the learning process both educational and enjoyable.

Why Climate Fresk Matters

The objective of the Climate Fresk initiative is to educate and empower individuals to take meaningful actions toward reducing greenhouse gas emissions and promoting sustainability. By participating in these workshops, PMI members can gain a deeper understanding of climate science, the



consequences of inaction, and the potential solutions that can be implemented at both individual and organizational levels.

PMI Europe's Commitment

PMI Europe has set an ambitious goal for 2024: to have at least 575 members attend Climate Fresk workshops across various chapters. This initiative is not only about education but also about building a community of informed and proactive project managers who can drive change within their respective fields.

Highlights from Recent Workshops

In the past months, several PMI chapters have successfully hosted Climate Fresk workshops with positive outcomes:

PMI Hungary's "Lunch & Learn" webinar attracted around 150 attendees, receiving high evaluations and generating interest in further participation.

PMI Northern Italy conducted a promotional webinar with 110 attendees, resulting in a strong interest in future workshops.

PMI Czech Republic hosted their first face-to-face workshop in Brno, which was well-received and led to plans for additional sessions during their annual project management conference

Wärtsiläs experience with Al



Wärtsilä's Al event: Supporting Project Management Efficiency.

On May 2, 2024, Wärtsilä Oyj Abp in Helsinki hosted an enlightening Al breakfast event. This gathering, attended by PMI Finland Chapter members and Wärtsilä employees interested in project management, provided a deep dive into the company's Al journey, practical applications, and future plans.

The event kicked off with an opening address by Mari-Elia Juhola and Donna Roberts, setting the stage for a series of insightful presentations. Tony Savander, a data scientist at Wärtsilä, detailed the company's Al initiatives, tracing their evolution from a handful of use cases in 2017 to over 100 today. He emphasized Wärtsilä's vision of a Gen Al-powered, employee-driven Al factory by 2025, leveraging data and Al assets alongside no-code tools for rapid deployment.

A significant highlight was the introduction of WartsilaGPT, an in-

house developed generative AI toolset. Justas Kieloutis and Teemu Sormunen showcased its early roles in HR, programming, finance, and internal communications, demonstrating its potential to transform operational efficiencies.

The presentations underscored how AI empowers project management, enhancing project cost estimation, resource allocation, risk management, scheduling, lessons learned, and reporting. Al's ability to mimic human intelligence and focus on value-driven tasks was particularly noted, reinforcing its role in supporting rather than replacing human effort

Throughout the event, the practical applications of AI in Wärtsilä's operations were showcased, including expert insight for anomaly detection, energy storage optimization, and fleet optimization services. These examples





illustrated Al's tangible benefits in improving efficiency, reducing costs, and driving innovation.

The session concluded with an interactive mingling segment, allowing attendees to network, exchange ideas, and discuss the presentations. The event successfully fostered a collaborative environment, leaving participants with valuable insights into responsible AI use and its integration into project management.

This AI breakfast event provided a stimulating platform for learning and discussion, highlighting Wärtsilä's pioneering efforts in AI and its profound impact on project management and operational efficiency. In summary, **New Members** trend keeps constant growth number, **Renewals** shows constant trend, together with **Non Renewals**, for members that have automatic-renewal off.




