# PMI Single Membership Model Coming 2026



#### What Changes in 2026

Starting in 2026, PMI Finland Chapter will transition to PMI's new Single Membership Model. This important change means your Chapter membership will be automatically linked to your PMI membership based on your registered home country.

#### What this means for you:

Your Chapter membership will be determined by your home country in your PMI profile

If Finland is your home country, you'll automatically join PMI Finland Chapter

If your home country is listed elsewhere, you'll be assigned to that country's Chapter

You will no longer need to purchase Chapter membership separately—it will be included with your PMI membership

Your membership fees for PMI and the Chapter will be combined into a single payment

#### **Action Required:**

To remain a member of PMI Finland Chapter, verify your home country is set to Finland in your PMI.org profile:

Log in at PMI.org

Click your name → Dashboard

Click "Edit Account" next to your photo

Scroll to "Addresses" section

Update home country to Finland if needed

#### **Important Notes:**

Once implemented, you cannot choose a Chapter separate from your home country

You can join multiple Chapters with additional purchases

Chapter membership will be mandatory with PMI membership


#### Catch up on the past 2025 events




#### **Chapter Statistics**
